### Instructions for Referees: Digital Humanities Fellowship

**About the Fellowship:** The Stanford Humanities Center may award a Digital Humanities Fellowship for the academic year 2009-2010 to a junior or senior scholar. The Digital Humanities Fellowship reflects the Stanford Humanities Center's commitment to supporting new directions in humanities research. The fellowship is directed to humanities scholars whose research methods are uniquely shaped by digital technologies or for whom humanities computing is an area of research.

**Instructions for Referees:** In writing your letter of reference for a candidate being considered for the 2009-2010 Digital Humanities Fellowship at the Stanford Humanities Center, it would be very helpful to the Center's Selection Committee if you kept in mind the following selection criteria:

- (1) The promise of the specific research project being proposed.
- (2) The research project's potential interest to scholars in different fields of the humanities.
- (3) The originality and intellectual distinction of the candidate's previous work.
- (4) The applicant's ability to engage in collegial interaction and to contribute to the discussion of presentations. Please comment on collegiality. This information is taken seriously in the selection process.

Please note that the **deadline** for applications is **October 15, 2008**, and the Selection Committee's consideration of reference letters received after that date cannot be guaranteed.
